QUALIFICATIONS FOR OFFICE

A person is qualified under section 32 of the *School Act* to be nominated, elected, and to hold office as a trustee of the Board of Education if they meet the following criteria:

- Canadian citizen;
- 18 years of age or older on general voting day (October 20)
- resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day nomination papers are filed;
- not disqualified under this *Act* or any other enactment from being nominated for, being elected to or holding office as a trustee, or be otherwise disqualified by law.
- A person whose term of office as trustee has expired or is about to expire is eligible for re-election if the person is otherwise qualified to be a trustee.
- At any one time, a person is not eligible to be nominated for or elected as trustee for more than one trustee electoral area for any one school district.
