### Radio Lillooet Emergency Bulletins

To help keep the community informed with the latest information on COVID-19 situation in the Lillooet region, Radio Lillooet is broadcasting Information Bulletins twice daily.

Radio Lillooet station manager Jeff O'Kelly said for the duration of the COVID-19 emergency he will be broadcasting Information Bulletins at **9:00 AM** and again at **4:00 PM seven days a week**.

Radio Lillooet (CHLS-FM, 100.5 on your dial) is a small non-profit radio station that serves the Lillooet area and has been on the air since 2000.

The station's COVID-19 Information Bulletins include recordings of information releases from the Lillooet Emergency Operations Centre.

The intent is to provide a daily, scheduled and up-to-date source for important local information about the COVID-19 emergency.

These local broadcasts are especially valuable during this time of emergency, and even more so with the announcement this week that the Bridge River-Lillooet News is suspending publication for the next 13 weeks.
