Public Notice is given to the electors of the District of Lillooet that nominations for the offices of:

### QUALIFICATIONS FOR OFFICE

A person is qualified to be nominated, elected, and to hold office as a member of local government if they meet the following criteria:

- Canadian citizen;
- 18 years of age or older on general voting day (Saturday, October 20, 2018);
- resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day nomination papers are filed;
- not disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from being nominated for, being elected to or holding the office, or be otherwise disqualified by law;
- aware of and understand the requirements and restrictions of the Local Elections Campaign Financing Act and fully intend to comply with those requirements and restrictions; and
- fully intend to accept the office if elected.
