Please call Municipal Hall, at 250.256.4289, and ask to speak with Kevin Taylor, or Nate Moyer, or email elections@lillooet.ca, if you have any questions related to your candidacy and the election. An appointment is strongly recommended to file your nomination papers to ensure there are no errors in your submission.

Accepting elected office is the highest order of public service and offers the opportunity to significantly influence the quality of life in our community. As such, it is not to be taken lightly. If, after serious consideration and consultation, you are willing to accept the challenge and demands of elected office, you must have your nomination forms completed and filed during the nomination period. The person being nominated is obligated to ensure that nomination documents are complete and received in accordance with the *Local Government Act*. The nomination period starts at 9:00 a.m. Tuesday, August 30, 2022 and ends at 4:00 p.m. on Friday, September 9, 2022.

In accordance with Section 116 of the *Local Government Act* the order of names on the ballot will be arranged alphabetically by last name. If two candidates share a last name, those candidates will be arranged alphabetically in order of their first name.
