



Water Safety Instructor Course

May-June 2022



This 40+ hour Red Cross water safety instructor course covers the requirements of completing the WSI Certificate (Screen, Teaching Experience, Online component and Pool/Classroom component). Candidates will learn the foundation of instructional skills including teaching methods, learning styles, physical principles, progressions, communication, safety supervision and feedback. Candidates are evaluated during eight hours of assistant teaching and through individual study assignments. Upon successful completion, candidates are certified as Water Safety Instructors. Bring a bathing suit, towel, pen, paper and lunch/snacks. **100% Attendance required.**

May 15, 2022 1:00-4:00pm: Prescreen & Course Intro

Candidates will receive their course materials for the online portion, login information and course outline. A practice skills session to screen & correct strokes will take place in the pool.

May 16-27: Online Component

Candidates will have two weeks to complete the online course materials. Certificate of completion must be sent to WSIT prior to starting teaching experience.

May 31-June 9 Tues/Thurs 6:00-8:00pm: Teaching Experience

Candidates will complete 8 hours of teaching experience with a current WSI— 4 hours Preschool and 4 hours Swim Kids. Must be completed and workbook signed prior to starting Classroom & Pool Module.

Saturdays June 11, 18 & 25 9:00am-5:00pm Classroom & Pool Component

****Please bring a tablet/laptop to work from for the Classroom/Pool Module.****

PREREQUISITES: Age 15 by last day of Classroom & Pool Component, Swim Kids Level 10 Skills or equivalent, & Bronze Cross.
